Collage picture  
in the wood.**

**Collect seeds to  
plant in the classroom  
or in the  
school grounds.**

**Make a 'Journey Stick' by  
collecting objects and fasten-  
ing them onto a stick with  
coloured wool to tell the  
story of your walk.**
