



Colour

Aims: *Make a rainbow using natural materials*

KEYSTAGE 1 Art: 1, 2a, 4a

To use this worksheet you also need either a glue stick or some double-sided sticky tape. If you use tape, stick a length of it down the centre of the page. When on site the pupils can peel off the backing paper to expose the sticky surface on which they can then collect natural examples of all seven colours of the rainbow. Alternatively take a glue stick out on site with you and use it as and when required.

In summer and autumn it should be possible to collect all the different colours needed for a rainbow. Please though do not pick wildflowers.

Collect natural materials of different colours and take them back to the classroom. Press clay into a wooden frame and then press the natural materials into the surface of the clay and leave to harden. If possible, look at pictures of the 'well dressings' produced in the Derbyshire Peak District which are produced using a similar method but on a much larger scale.
